

# Pre-show workshop

During the pre-show workshop, we will be showing you how to make two types of fish - one that you can decorate and an origami fish.

You can find a template of the fish to decorate in this document. Print and cut the fish out, or have fun drawing your own fish outline. Then have some pencils, pens or crayons ready to decorate your fish during the workshop.

For the origami fish, you will need a piece of square paper, we recommend 15cm x 15cm.

(Origami paper is ideal, but any coloured or plain paper will work; card or cartridge paper is too thick).

# Props


To have a really interactive experience when watching Swish online, it would be great if you can gather these items to have with you during the show.

The characters will let you know when to use each item.

- **Bubble mixture**  
(or washing up liquid also works)
- **Bingo card**  
(template in this guide or draw your own out on a piece of paper, using a 4 x 4 grid with numbers 1-16)
- **Paddles: 1 & 3 and Dolphin & Crab**  
(templates in this guide or draw your own 1, 3, dolphin and crab pictures)
- **Pillow, cushion or blanket**
- **Soft ball**
- **Soft brush**

If you do not have any or some of the items we've listed, that is ok, you will still be able to join in with the show.




